- Coordinates Pep Band



## LEADERSHIP TEAM

### **SECTION LEADER (1-2 per section) Appointed Positions**

**Section Leaders are the musical leader of their section. Responsibilities include...**

- Represents the Mt. Hebron Band/Marching Unit of the Past, Present and Future
- Cooperates & Collaborates with **ALL** Members, Staff, and Parents
- Leads by Example
- Provides musical leadership during sectionals
- Assists with teaching/learning music
- Music Memorization (Check-Offs)
- Instrument Cleaning/Maintenance
- Organizes and manages music distribution
- Organizes section bonding experiences
- Assists with the management of Music Library
- Liaison between their section and the Executive Board

### **SQUAD LEADER (1-2 per section) Appointed Positions**

**A MtHMU Squad Leader is the marching leader of their section. Responsibilities include...**

- Represents the Mt. Hebron Band/Marching Unit of the Past, Present and Future
- Cooperates & Collaborates with **ALL** Members, Staff, and Parents
- Leads by Example
- Provides marching leadership during sectionals
- Assists with teaching/learning drill
- Drill Memorization (Check-Offs)
- Uniform Cleaning/Maintenance
- Organizes and manages drill - coordinate sheet distribution
- Lines up horns
- Organizes section bonding experiences
- Assists with the management of uniforms, including: distribution, inspection, and collection
- Liaison between their section and the Executive Board

### **FIELD CREW (6-8) Appointed Positions**

**A MtHMU Squad Leader is the marching leader of their section. Responsibilities include...**

- Represents the Mt. Hebron Band/Marching Unit of the Past, Present and Future
- Cooperates & Collaborates with **ALL** Members, Staff, and Parents
- Leads by Example
- Setting / Cleaning the field for rehearsal, including: podiums, yard markers, cones, chalk, water, etc.
- Assist Front Ensemble with equipment
